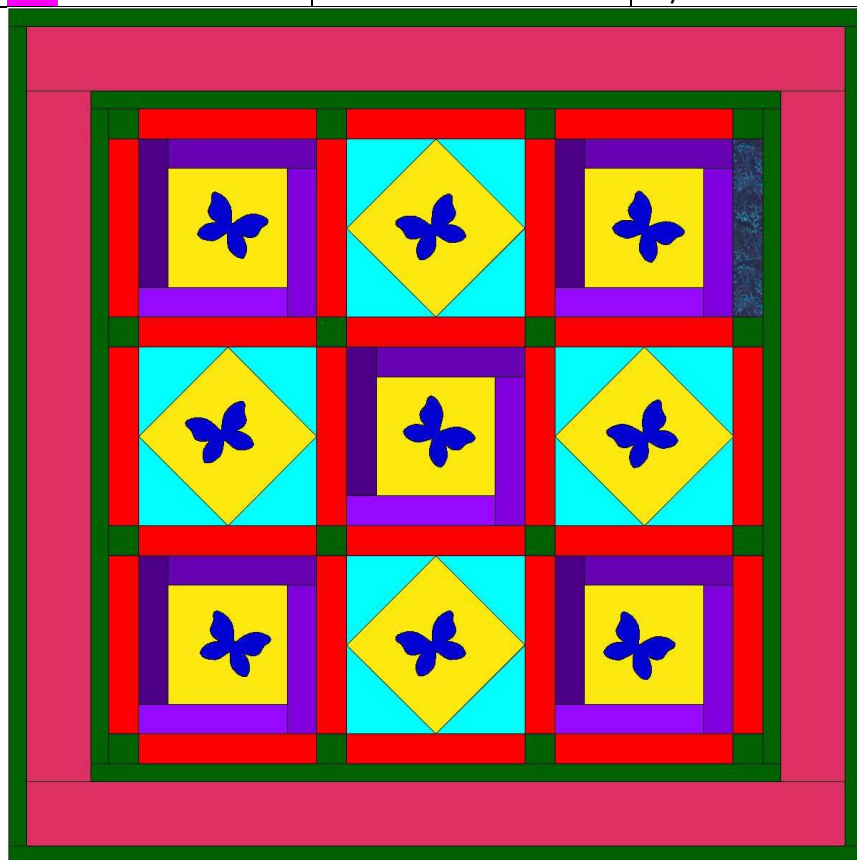


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Fabric Requirements:

Use fabric colorway chart below to identify fabrics and yardage

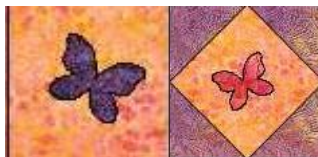
Color	Description	Yardage
Yellow	Background of butterfly squares	½ yard
Blue	Butterflies	9 pieces of scrap fabric
Light Blue	Triangles around on point butterflies	½ yard
Purple	Strips around Butterflies	Four different colors of 1/8 yard each
Red	Sashing	½ yard
Green	Corner Squares and 1" border, binding	3/4 yard
Pink	3" border	1 yard



Cutting Instructions:

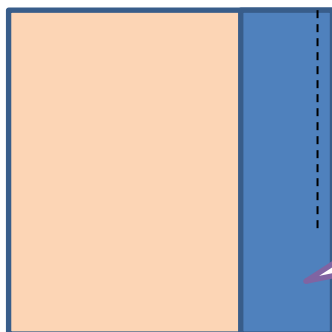
1. Cut 9 6 ½" squares of background fabric.
2. Fuse double sided webbing to various colored scraps of fabric. Cut 9 butterflies.
3. Cut strips for 5 butterfly squares:
 - a. Cut 5 2 ¼" x 8 3/8" strips of color A.
 - b. Cut 5 2 ¼" x 8 3/8" strips of color B.
 - c. Cut 5 2 ¼" x 8 3/8" strips of color C.
 - d. Cut 5 2 ¼" x 8 3/8" strips of color D.
4. Cut 8 6 ½" squares for triangles for on point butterfly squares. Cut each square in half diagonally.
5. Cut 16 2 ½" corner squares for sashing.
6. Cut 4 1 ½" strips of inner border color.
7. Cut 5 2 ½" strips of binding color.
8. Cut 4 3 ½" strips of outer border color.
9. Cut 24 2 ½" x 10" strips for sashing.

Assembly:

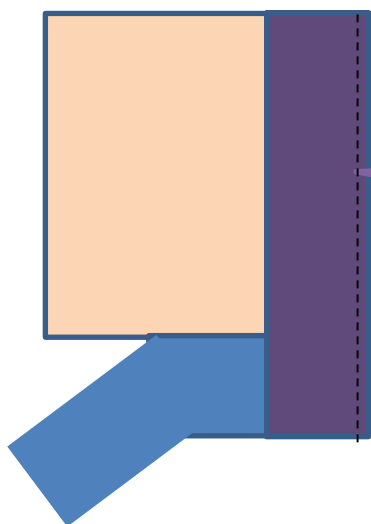


Fuse butterflies to 6 ½" squares of fabric. Arrange the butterflies so that they are in different positions. Remember that 4 of the butterfly squares are on point, the rest are square to the quilt. Stitch around the edges of the butterflies. Here is a great chance for creativity. Play with your decorative stitches on your machine and choose one or many to sew the butterflies down. Play with thread colors, too.

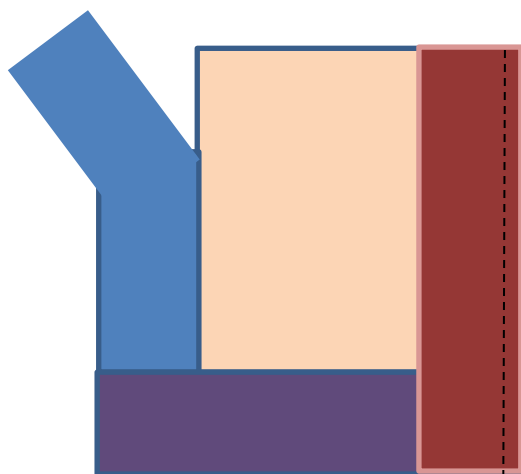




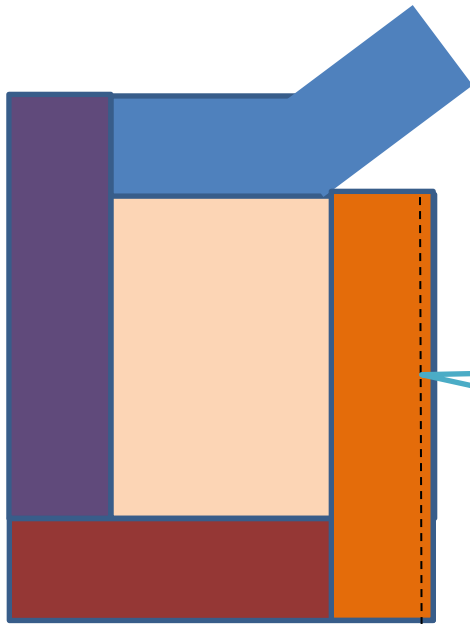
Sew Color A $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{3}{8}$ " strip to $6\frac{1}{2}$ " square.
 Make sure to use the squares where the butterflies are NOT on point. Only sew about $\frac{3}{4}$ of the seam. We will finish this seam at the end of the block. Press seam to strip side.



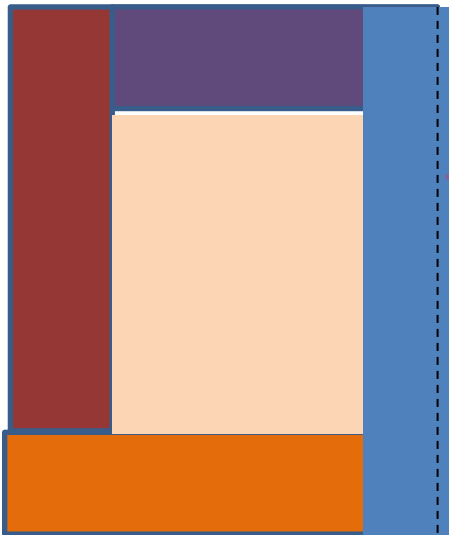
Sew Color B $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{3}{8}$ " strip to block. This time, sew the complete seam. Press seam towards strip.



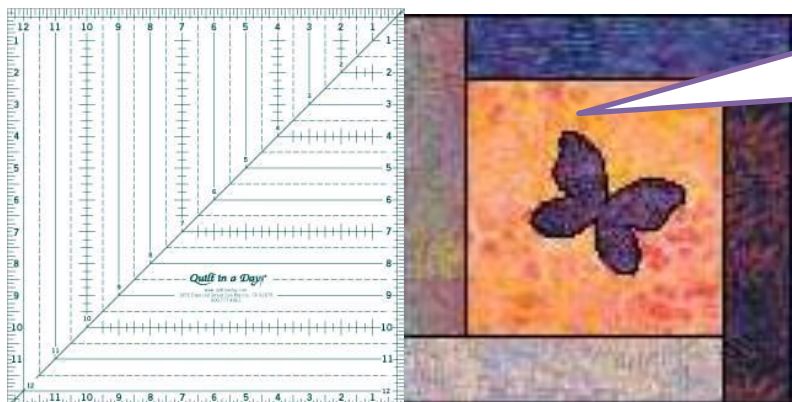
Repeat with color C



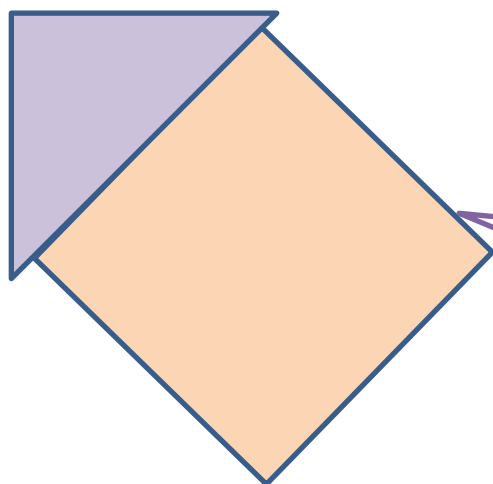
Repeat with Color D



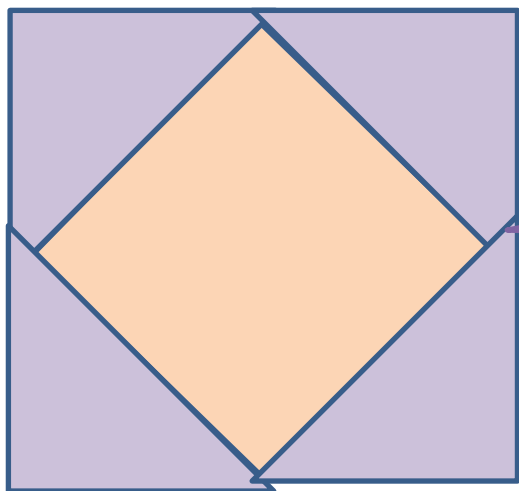
Finish sewing the first seam.



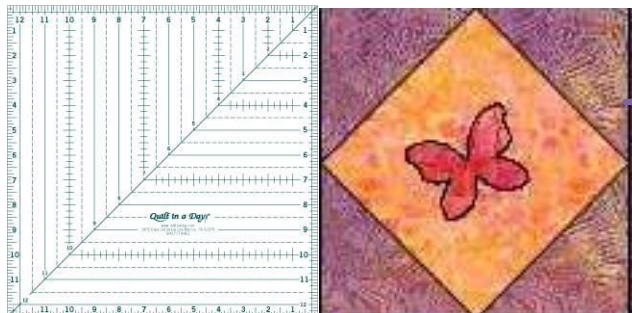
You just **finished** the first block! Use a square it up to 10". Great job! You need five blocks like this.



Now sew one of the triangles onto the side of one of the on point butterfly squares. The triangle will be bigger than the square. We will square it up to the proper size in the end. Press seam towards triangle.



Repeat for other 3 sides, being sure to press the seam before adding another triangle.



Make a total of 4 of these squares, square then up to 10" also.



Begin building the rows by adding the $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10" strips to the blocks as shown. Press seams towards blocks. Make three rows.



Assemble sashing rows by sewing $2\frac{1}{2}$ " cornerstone blocks to $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10" strips as shown. Press seams towards strips. Make four of these strips.



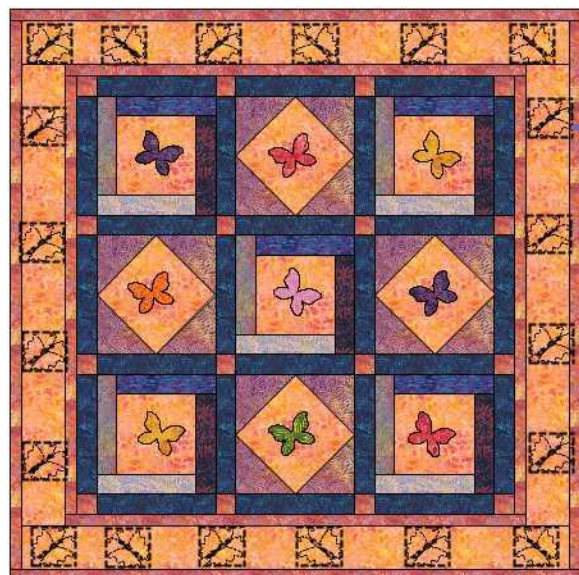
Sew blocks and sashings together as shown. Press seams towards strips.



Add one inch border, press seams towards 1" border.

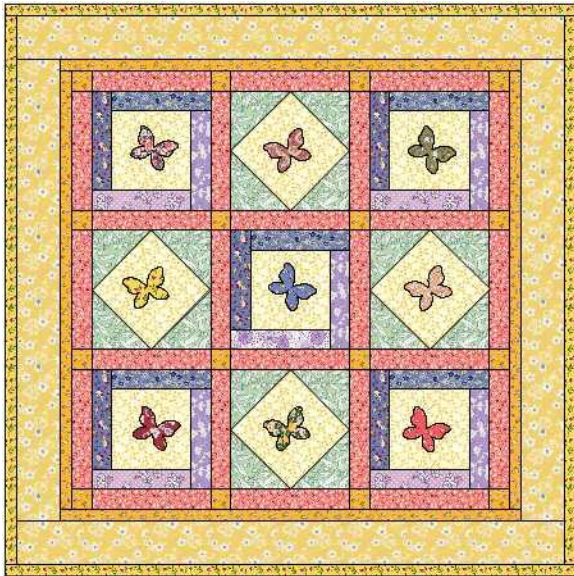


Add 3" border, press seams toward 3" border.

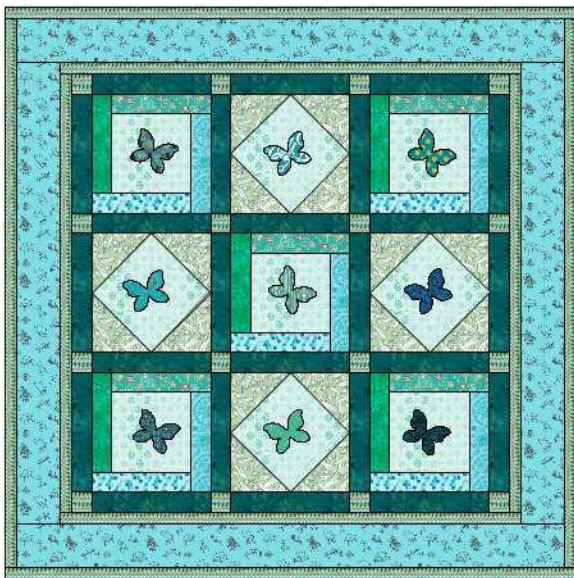


Layer quilt, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. I think it would be fun to freehand quilt little butterflies on the outside borders!
Bind quilt. Enjoy!
